Care for your Equipment

It does not take much dust, grit or sand to get inside your camera to cause dysfunctions and upset a digital cameras' sensors.

A little forward planning if your shooting at the likes of a beach, a rodeo, even in windy weather – go with just 1 lens or if you do want to swap a lens use an enclosed area for changing, such as your car, change rooms and yes even a phone booth, a shoulder bag – well maybe, does it have hooks and sinkers in it? Why not grab a freezer bag – it easily fits in your pocket and is an effective cover.
